- 3) A pergola with 6"x 6" posts set 12' on center.


Project Scope: Construction of additional elements to meet property owner's needs

Project Narrative: Before we move into our new house, I would like to add three elements: a fence, a storage shed, and a pergola. The fence will provide privacy along the western property line and secure a yard for our dog. The storage shed will free up space in our garage, and the pergola will provide an outdoor sitting area. A foundation survey is provided that details the location of each element.

1) Fence – The proposed fence will be of two types: A 6' privacy fence and a living fence composed of posts, welded wire fencing, and Confederate jasmine. Once the jasmine is established, it creates a solid vegetative barrier that is evergreen and attracts pollinators. I have used this type of fence before, and the effect is very pleasing. The construction is minimalist and unobtrusive. Below are some examples of a new installation and one that has matured.








2) Storage Shed – I would like to construct a storage shed as a hobby/work area separate from the garage. The product selected has the same 12/12 roof pitch as the house and garage and will be painted to match. Roof shingles will also replicate the main structure. Footprint of the shed is 12' x 8', so the impact is minimal. Below are stock images of the shed kit.





3) Pergola – The last element proposed is a wooden pergola which will be used as an outdoor sitting area. The structure will be constructed of 6" x 6" posts (12'on center), 2" x 10" x 16' beams, and 2" x 8" x 16' rafters. Through bolts secure the beams to the posts, and lag screws secure the rafters to the beams in four places per rafter. All wood is stained a dark cedar color. Below is an image of what I built at our current house.
