BID ADVERTISEMENT

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Senoia until 11:00 am, August 23, 2018, at Senoia City Hall, 80 Main Street, Senoia, GA. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 11:01 am. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time or receipt of bids for a period of two hundred ten (210) days. A 5% bid bond (or certified check in lieu of bond) is required.

The work to be done consists of the furnishing of all materials, labor and equipment for the complete construction of the **SR 16 Intersection Improvements & Bridge Replacement project**, hereinafter referred to as the "**PROJECT**", including, but not limited to, bridge culvert replacement, guardrail installation, paving, installation and placement of rip rap, earthwork and grading, erosion and sediment control, maintenance of traffic and detouring at locations indicated in the plan set. A construction timeframe of 360 calendar days is anticipated.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 am, August 10, 2018, at Senoia City Hall, 80 Main Street, Senoia, GA. Only Bidders on record with the City of Senoia as having received an original bid package may submit bids. Responses will be issued via addendum by 5:00 pm on August 17, 2018.

Please note Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, 2013 Edition, GDOT Supplemental Specifications Book, 2016 Edition, and applicable Supplemental Specifications and Special Provisions apply to this project. A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of thirteen percent (13%) applies to this project.

The City of Senoia in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d—42 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, part 21, Nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin in consideration for an award. The City of Senoia reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive formalities.

- Bidders submitting bids over \$2,000,000 shall be prequalified with the GDOT.
- Bidders submitting bids \$2,000,000 or less shall be prequalified or registered subcontractors with the GDOT.

Per GDOT specification 103.05, a required performance bond is to be 100% of the contract amount and a required payment bond is to be 110% of the contract amount.
